Notice of Public Hearing

On Thursday, June 9, 2022, at 3 p.m., the SVBGSA Board of Directors will hold a public hearing on Zoom to consider adopting a resolution to increase the Groundwater Sustainability Fee for the Salinas Valley Groundwater Basin depicted in the map below. The regulatory fee supports the typical annual operation costs of the Agency's regulatory program as authorized by the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act, including the development and revision of groundwater sustainability plans. The Fee is reviewed every year by the SVBGSA Board of Directors.

Under the proposed increased fee schedule, agricultural beneficiaries would continue to be responsible for 90% of the Fee revenue and all other beneficiaries would continue to be responsible for 10% of the Fee revenue. The table below summarizes the changes to the Fee. The increased Fee is estimated to fund \$1,750,385 (100%) of Fiscal Year 2022/2023 operating costs.

The Fee is collected in the same manner as ad valorem property taxes pursuant to Water Code section 10730 (d) with the exception of some service connections, which are billed directly by the SVBGSA.
