Well Registration and GEMS Expansion Update


OCTOBER 28, 2024

A new ordinance with well registration and groundwater reporting requirements was adopted on October 1, 2024.

- Monterey County Water Resources Agency (MCWRA) Ordinance No. 5426
 - Repealed three ordinances related to groundwater extraction.
 - Covers well registration, groundwater extraction reporting, groundwater level, and groundwater quality monitoring.
 - Provides for collection of a regulatory fee.
- Adopting resolution approved and implemented the MCWRA "Groundwater Monitoring Program Manual."
 - Describes groundwater monitoring activities and will guide implementation of the Groundwater Monitoring Program.



What is the Groundwater Monitoring Program?





Geographic area of the Groundwater Monitoring Program (GMP)

- MCWRA has authority throughout Monterey County but, at present, the GMP will be implemented in:
 - MCWRA Zone 2C
 - 180/400-Foot Aquifer, Eastside Aquifer, Forebay Aquifer, Langley Area, Monterey, and Upper Valley Aquifer Subbasins





There are changes to well registration and groundwater extraction reporting requirements.

Well registration

- All wells within the defined geographic area must be registered with MCWRA.
- Online portal is under development. In the interim, a form is available on MCWRA's website.
- Registration is required within 30 days of completed construction of a new well or upon request from MCWRA.

There are changes to well registration and groundwater extraction reporting requirements.

- Groundwater extraction reporting
 - All wells in the defined area that extract more than two acre-feet per year must report pumping data to MCWRA through the Groundwater Extraction Management System (GEMS).
 - Details on approved methods for tracking data are described in the GMP Manual.
 - Phased rollout of expanding requirements:
 - Reporting data for 2024 Well owners/operators who have been required to report to GEMS historically will continue to do so, for pumping in 2024.
 - Begin collecting data in 2024 Non-de minimis agricultural, industrial, and municipal wells. Includes domestic users with 15 or more connections.
 - Begin collecting data in 2025 Domestic users with 5-14 connections.



2024 will be a transition year for GEMS timelines.

- The GMP Manual describes a deadline of November 1 for reporting groundwater extraction data.
 - Given the timeline of adoption of Ordinance No. 5426, this is could not be implemented for reporting data from 2024.

- In 2024, GEMS deadlines will follow a transitional schedule from MCWRA's historical GEMS timeline to the new timeline in the GMP Manual.
 - GEMS reporting for 2024 will follow the new data timeframe (Water Year) with an adjusted deadline.



Well owners/operators required to submit data for 2024 pumping will need to do so by January 10, 2025.

Oct. 29, 2024 to Nov. 8, 2024

- Well Information Verification
- 2-week period for administrative changes only

Nov. 12, 2024 to Jan. 10, 2025

- Submit groundwater extraction data using GEMS online portal
- Pumping data for Oct. 2023 to Sep. 2024 (Water Year 2024)

Jan. 10, 2025

• GEMS reporting for Water Year 2024 ends



Looking ahead to reporting data for Water Year 2025...

- Well owners/operators who are new to GEMS need to start collecting monthly extraction data as soon as possible.
 - MCWRA will be contacting well owners/operators with information about monthly data gathering and annual reporting requirements.
- Reporting data from WY 2025 will follow the timeline described in the GMP Manual:
 - The period to submit data will run from October 1-31.
 - All data are due to MCWRA by November 1.
 - Extraction data must include monthly totals for the Water Year (October 1-September 30).
